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     BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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  10 Section 1. SCHOOL HEALTH INSURANCE REFORM TEAM STUDY.
11 insurance division of the department of commerce shall
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1 12 establish a school health insurance reform team. The school
1 13 health insurance reform team shall conduct a study to review
  14 the availability of affordable health insurance coverage for
1 15 school district employees, insurance ratings practices, the
1 16 establishment of continuity of coverage for school districts
  17 and their employees, and methods to improve the efficiency and
  18 fairness of the health insurance marketplace for school
1 19 districts and their employees. The study shall include a
  20 comparison of health insurance coverage that is offered to
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  21 school district employees, to other public employees, and to
1 22 employees in the private sector. The school health insurance
1 23 reform team shall examine the feasibility of the following:
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         1. Establishing a premium rating system based on the
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  25 statewide health status, claims experience, and other
1 26 demographic characteristics of school district employees.
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         2. Establishing basic or standard health benefit plans
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  28 with benefit levels, cost=sharing levels, exclusions, and
1 29 limitations available to all school districts and their
1 30 employees.
         3. Establishing uniform coverage plans with benefit
  32 coverages that may be added to the basic or standard plans, at
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1 33 the option of a school district.
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         4. Establishing restrictions on premium rates and rate
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  35 increases.
         5. Establishing a school district health reinsurance
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   2 program.
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        The commissioner of insurance shall select the members of
   4 the school health insurance reform team which shall include a
   5 representative of a school district with fewer than six
   6 hundred students, a representative of a school district with
   7 six hundred to nine hundred ninety=nine students, a
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   8 representative of a school district with one thousand or more
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 9 students, a representative of the Iowa association of school 10 boards, a representative of a collective bargaining
  11 organization that represents school district employees, a
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  12 representative of a health insurance carrier, a representative
2 13 of a health insurance provider, a representative of an area 2 14 education agency, and others, who, in the opinion of the
2 15 commissioner, have expertise that would assist the team in
  16 accomplishing its purpose.
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         The commissioner shall submit a report to the general
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 18 assembly on or before January 15, 2004, regarding the team's 19 findings and recommendations, including proposed legislation,
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  20 concerning health insurance coverage for school districts and
  21 their employees.
