AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF IDENTITY THEFT BY MAKING CHANGES IN THE ELEMENTS OF THE OFFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 715A.8, subsection 2, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

2. A person commits the offense of identity theft if the person with-the-intent-to-obtain-a-benefit fraudulently obtains-identification-information-of-another-person-and uses or attempts to <u>fraudulently</u> use that <u>identification</u> information of another person, with the intent to obtain
