RELATING TO THE USE OF PHYSICAL PLANT AND EQUIPMENT LEVY  
REVENUE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 298.3, subsections 3 and 10, Code 2003,  
are amended to read as follows:

3. ~~The purchase-of-buildings-and-the~~ purchase, lease, or  
lease-purchase of a single unit of equipment or technology  
exceeding five hundred dollars in value per unit.


10. ~~Lease-purchase~~ The purchase of buildings or lease-  
purchase option agreements for school buildings ~~and-for~~  
~~equipment-exceeding-in-value-five-thousand-dollars-per-single~~  
unit.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
