

HOUSE FILE 2180

AN ACT

RELATING TO FILLING THE OFFICE OF COUNTY ATTORNEY BY APPOINTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 69.14A, subsection 2, paragraph a, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

By appointment by the board of supervisors. The appointment shall be for the period until the next pending election as defined in section 69.12, and shall be made within forty days after the vacancy occurs. If the board of supervisors chooses to proceed under this paragraph, the board shall publish notice in the manner prescribed by section 331.305 stating that the board intends to fill the vacancy by appointment but that the electors of the county have the right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by special election. The board may publish notice in advance if an elected official submits a resignation to take effect at a future date. The board may make an appointment to fill the vacancy after the notice is published or after the vacancy occurs, whichever is later. A person appointed to an office under this subsection, except for a county attorney, shall

have actually resided in the county which the appointee represents sixty days prior to appointment. <u>A person</u> <u>appointed to the office of county attorney shall be a resident</u> <u>of the county at the time of appointment.</u>
