
AUTHORIZING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS TO

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:


Section 1. Section 256.11, Code 2003, is amended by adding
the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 15. The board of directors of a school
district or the authorities in charge of a nonpublic school
may award credit toward graduation to a student if the student
successfully completes basic training in the Iowa army
national guard, the Iowa air national guard, or as a member of
the active military forces of the United States or as a member

of the army national guard of the United States or the air national guard of the United States.
