
RELATING TO CERTAIN NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATIONS RETAINING ABANDONED PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 499.30A, subsection 4, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:


Any A disbursement having an aggregate value of fifty dollars or more that is retained by the cooperative association shall be forfeited to the cooperative association only if the cooperative association publishes at least one notice of the abandoned property in a publication regularly distributed to its membership or in a newspaper having a general circulation in the county where the cooperative

association is located. The notice shall include all of the following:


