

HOUSE FILE 2306

AN ACT

RELATING TO FEES CHARGED FOR DELAYED REDEMPTION OF ELECTRONIC GIFT CARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 556.9, subsection 2, Code Supplement 2003, is amended to read as follows:

2. An issuer of a gift certificate shall not deduct from the face value of the gift certificate any charge imposed due to the failure of the owner of the gift certificate to present the gift certificate in a timely manner, unless a valid and enforceable written contract exists between the issuer and the owner of the gift certificate pursuant to which the issuer regularly imposes such charges and does not regularly reverse or otherwise cancel them. For purposes of this subsection, "gift certificate" means a merchandise certificate <u>or</u> <u>electronic gift card</u> conspicuously designated as a gift

certificate or electronic gift card, and generally purchased by a buyer for use by a person other than the buyer.
