AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF BLAZE ORANGE APPAREL BY HUNTERS AND SUBJECTING VIOLATORS TO A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 481A.122, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

481A.122 DEER-HUNTERS' HUNTERS' ORANGE APPAREL.

A person shall not hunt deer with firearms unless the person is at the time wearing one or more of the following articles of visible, external apparel: A vest, coat, jacket, sweatshirt, sweater, shirt, or coveralls, the color and material of which shall be solid blaze orange. A person shall not hunt upland game birds, as defined by the department, unless the person is at the time wearing one or more of the following articles of visible, external apparel: A hat, cap, vest, coat, jacket, sweatshirt, sweater, shirt, or coveralls,
