AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AMOUNT OF MUSSELS AND SHELLS WHICH MAY  
BE TAKEN PURSUANT TO A SPORT FISHING LICENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:


Section 1. Section 482.12, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 2003, is amended by striking the paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

a. A sport fishing license entitles a person to take and possess a maximum amount of mussels or shells daily as

authorized by rule of the department or commission under the authority of sections 456A.24, 481A.38, 481A.39, and 482.1.
