The above House File is hereby approved this date.



HOUSE FILE 551

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A FEE FOR TRANSPORTING AN INMATE FOR MEDICAL OR DENTAL CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 904.108, subsection 6, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

6. The director may charge an inmate a correctional fee for custodial expenses incurred or which may be incurred while the inmate is in the custody of the department. The custodial expenses may include, but are not limited to, board and room, medical and dental fees <u>including any necessary transportation</u> <u>fee not to exceed five dollars per visit</u>, education costs, clothing costs, and the costs of supervision, services, and treatment to the inmate. The correctional fee shall not exceed the actual cost of keeping the inmate in custody. The correctional fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be credited as a reimbursement to the appropriate correctional

institution. This subsection does not limit the right of the director to obtain any other remedy authorized by law.
