AN ACT


RELATING TO THE EXEMPTION FROM LAND OWNERSHIP RESTRICTIONS
FOR NONRESIDENT ALIENS UNDER THE NEW JOBS AND INCOME PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 15.331B, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:

The eligible business may receive one or more ~~one-year~~ extensions of the time limit for complying with the requirements of section 9I.4. Each extension must be approved by the community prior to approval by the department. An eligible business may receive one five-year extension and one or more one-year extensions. The eligible business shall

comply with the remaining provisions of chapter 9I to the extent they do not conflict with this subsection.
