I hereby transmit:

**House File 2333**, an Act prohibiting a person or club holding a liquor control license or retail wine or beer permit from distributing or possessing machines used to vaporize an alcoholic beverage for consumption and making penalties applicable.

**House File 2337**, an Act relating to the use of a peace officer of the department of public safety in an industrial dispute and providing an effective date.

**House File 2569**, an Act relating to the operation of all-terrain vehicles on the highway for limited purposes.

HOUSE FILE 2333

AN ACT

PROHIBITING A PERSON OR CLUB HOLDING A LIQUOR CONTROL LICENSE  
OR RETAIL WINE OR BEER PERMIT FROM DISTRIBUTING OR POSSESSING  
MACHINES USED TO VAPORIZE AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE FOR  
CONSUMPTION AND MAKING PENALTIES APPLICABLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 123.49, subsection 2, Code 2005, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:


NEW PARAGRAPH. 1. Sell, give, possess, or otherwise supply a machine which is used to vaporize an alcoholic

beverage for the purpose of being consumed in a vaporized form.
