AN ACT

DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF REGENTS TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE
ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS COMMON TO THE STATE UNIVERSITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS
STUDY. The state board of regents shall conduct a study
relating to the admission requirements common to the three
state universities, including administrative rule 681 IAC
1.1(1), which provides that graduates of approved Iowa high
schools who have the subject matter backgrounds as recommended
by each university and who rank in the upper one-half of their
graduating class will be admitted. The state board shall
submit a report to the senate and house of representatives
standing committees on education by January 8, 2007, regarding
the findings and recommendations of the study.
