1 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 10 Section 1. Section 22.7, subsection 5, Code Supplement
1 11 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1 12 5. Peace officers' investigative reports, and specific
1 13 portions of electronic mail and telephone billing records of
1 14 law enforcement agencies if that information is part of an
1 15 ongoing investigation, except where disclosure is authorized
1 16 elsewhere in this Code. However, the date, time, specific
1 17 location, and immediate facts and circumstances surrounding a
1 18 crime or incident shall not be kept confidential under this
1 19 section, except in those unusual circumstances where
1 20 disclosure would plainly and seriously jeopardize an
1 21 investigation or pose a clear and present danger to the safety
1 22 of an individual. Specific portions of electronic mail and
1 23 telephone billing records may be kept confidential under this
1 24 subsection only for as long as the statute of limitations
1 25 would have run on a respective crime that is under
1 26 investigation.
