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           Section 1. Section 306A.3, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
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  1 12 2005, is amended to read as follows:
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           The department shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 17A,
  1 14 embodying a utility accommodation policy which imposes
1 15 reasonable restrictions on placements occurring on or after
  1 16 the effective date of the rules, on primary road rights=of=
  1 17 way. The rules may require utilities to give notice to the 1 18 department prior to installation of a utility system on a
  1 19 primary road right=of=way and obtain prior permission from the
    20 department for the proposed installation. The rules shall
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    21 recognize emergency situations and the need for immediate
  1 22 installation of service extensions subject to the standards
  1 23 adopted by the department and the utilities board. The rules
    24 shall be no less stringent than the standards adopted by the
    25 utilities board pursuant to chapters 478, 479, 479A, and 479B.
  1 26 This paragraph shall not be construed as granting the
    27 department authority which has been expressly granted to the
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    28 utilities board to determine the route of utility
  1 29 installations. If the department requires a utility company
    30 permit, the department shall be required to act upon the
    31 permit application within thirty days of its filing. In cases 32 of federal=aid highway projects on nonprimary highways, the
    33 local authority with jurisdiction over the highway and the 34 department shall comply with all federal regulations and 35 statutes regarding utility accommodation.

           It is the purpose of the general assembly in enacting this
     5 law to confer upon the utilities board the power and authority
     6 to implement certain controls over the transportation of
     7 natural gas to protect landowners and tenants from
    8 environmental or economic damages which may result from the
     9 construction, operation, or maintenance of a pipeline within
  2 10 the state. It is also the purpose of the general assembly in
    11 enacting this law to provide for the board to act as an agent
  2 12 for the federal government in determining pipeline company
  2 13 compliance with the standards of the federal government for
  2 14 pipelines within the boundaries of the state.
