Section 7.17, Code 2005, is amended to read as 1 8 1 9 follows: 1 10 7.17 OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES CO-ORDINATOR 1 11 <u>COORDINATOR</u>. 1 12 <u>1.</u> The governor shall establish the office of the 1 13 administrative rules  $\frac{\text{co-ordinator}}{\text{co-ordinator}}$ , and appoint its 1 14 staff, which shall be a part of the governor's office. The 15 administrative rules co-ordinator coordinator shall receive 1 1 16 all notices and rules adopted pursuant to chapter 17A and 1 17 provide the governor with an opportunity to review and object 1 18 to any rule as provided in chapter 17A. 1 19 2. The In consultation with the administrative rules co-20 ordinator in consultation with coordinator, the administrative 1 1 21 code editor shall prescribe a uniform style and form by which 1 22 an agency shall prepare and file a rule pursuant to chapter 1 23 17A, which shall correlate each rule to a uniform numbering 1 24 system devised by the administrative rules co-ordinator code 25 editor and which shall provide for electronic filing and 26 publication of the rules from the database used to produce the 27 official publications of the administrative rules of this 28 state. The administrative rules co-ordinator code editor 29 shall review all submitted rules for style and form and notify 30 the administrative rules coordinator if a rule is not in 1 31 proper style or form as provided in section 2B.5, and may 1 32 return or revise a rule which is not in proper style and form. 1 33 In prescribing the <u>The</u> style and form, the administrative 34 rules co-ordinator prescribed shall require that the agency 1 35 include a reference to the statute which the rules are 2 1 intended to implement. Sec. 2. Section 17A.4, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 2 2 2 3 2005, is amended to read as follows: 2 4 a. Give notice of its intended action by submitting three 5 copies of the notice to the administrative rules coordinator, 2 2 6 who and the administrative code editor. The administrative 2 7 rules coordinator shall assign an ARC number to each 2 8 rulemaking document and forward two copies to the. 7 2 9 administrative code editor for publication shall publish each 10 notice meeting the requirements of this chapter in the Iowa 2 11 administrative bulletin created pursuant to section 17A.6. 2 12 Any notice of intended action shall be published at least 2 13 thirty=five days in advance of the action. The notice shall 2 14 include a statement of either the terms or substance of the 2 15 intended action or a description of the subjects and issues 2 16 involved, and the time when, the place where, and the manner 2 17 in which interested persons may present their views. 2 18 Sec. 3. Section 17A.5, subsection 1, Code 2005, is amended 2 19 to read as follows: 2 20 1. Each agency shall file in each rule adopted by the 21 agency with the office of the administrative rules coordinator 2 22 three certified copies of each rule adopted by it and provide 23 an exact copy to the administrative code editor. The 24 administrative rules coordinator shall assign an ARC number to 2 2 25 each rulemaking document and forward two copies to the 26 administrative code editor. The administrative rules 2 27 coordinator shall keep a permanent register of the rules open 2 28 to public inspection. <u>The administrative code editor shall</u> 29 publish each rule adopted in accordance with this chapter in <u>30 the Iowa administrative code.</u> 2 2 31 Sec. 4. Section 17A.6, subsection 2, Code 2005, is amended 2 32 to read as follows: 2 33 2. Subject to the direction of In consultation with the 2 34 administrative rules coordinator, the administrative code 2 35 editor shall cause the Iowa administrative code to be 1 compiled, indexed, and published in accordance with section 3 2 2.42 in a form containing all rules adopted and filed by each 3 3 3 agency.
