1 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 9 Section 1. Section 237.16, subsection 1, Code 2005, is
1 10 amended to read as follows:
1 11 1. The child advocacy board is created within the
1 12 department of inspections and appeals. The state board
1 13 consists of nine members appointed by the governor, subject to
1 14 confirmation by the senate and directly responsible to the
1 15 governor. One member shall be an active court appointed
1 16 special advocate volunteer, one member shall be an active
1 17 member of a local citizen foster care review board, and one
1 18 member shall be a judicial branch employee or judicial officer
1 19 appointed from nominees submitted by the judicial branch. The
1 20 appointment is for a term of four years that begins and ends
1 21 as provided in section 69.19. Vacancies on the state board
1 22 shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments
1 23 are made.
