Section 543B.15, Code 2005, is amended by 1 10 adding the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 10. An applicant for an initial real 1 11 1 12 estate broker's or salesperson's license shall be subject to a 1 13 national criminal history check through the federal bureau of 14 investigation. The commission shall request the criminal 1 15 history check and shall provide the applicant's fingerprints 1 16 to the department of public safety for submission through the 1 17 state criminal history repository to the federal bureau of 1 18 investigation. The applicant shall authorize release of the 1 19 results of the criminal history check to the real estate 20 commission. The applicant shall pay the actual cost of the 1 21 fingerprinting and criminal history check, if any. Unless the 1 22 criminal history check was completed within the ninety 1 23 calendar days prior to the date the license application is 24 received by the real estate commission, the commission shall 1 25 reject and return the application to the applicant.
