  1 32 dollars of the assessed value of all taxable property in a
  1 33 regional transit district to the extent provided in this
     34 section. The chapter 28E agreement may authorize the 35 commission to levy the tax at different rates within the
     1 participating cities and counties in amounts sufficient to
     2 meet the revenue responsibilities of such cities and counties
     3 as allocated in the budget adopted by the commission.
     4 However, for a city participating in a regional transit 5 district, the total of all the tax levies imposed in the city 6 pursuant to section 384.12, subsection 10, and this section
