1 4 RELATING TO CONFIDENTIALITY AND LIABILITY PROVISIONS
1 5 INVOLVING THE CHILD ADVOCACY BOARD AND THE PROGRAMS
1 6 ASSOCIATED WITH THE BOARD AND MAKING A PENALTY APPLICABLE.

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1 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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1 10 Section 1. Section 232.13, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code
1 11 2005, is amended to read as follows:
1 12 b. A court appointed special advocate and the members of
1 13 the child advocacy board created in section 237.16 or a local
1 14 citizen foster care review board created in accordance with
1 15 section 237.19.

1 16 Sec. 2. Section 232.147, subsection 3, paragraph c, Code
1 17 2005, is amended to read as follows:
1 18 c. The child's parent, guardian or custodian, court
1 19 appointed special advocate, and guardian ad litem, and the
1 20 members of the child advocacy board created in section 237.16
1 21 or a local citizen foster care review board created in
1 22 accordance with section 237.19 who are assigning or reviewing
1 23 the child's case.

1 24 Sec. 3. Section 237.21, subsections 1 and 3, Code 2005,
1 25 are amended to read as follows:
1 26 1. The information and records of or provided to a local
1 27 board, or the state board, or court appointed special advocate
1 28 regarding a child receiving foster care and the child's family
1 29 when relating to the foster care placement are not public
1 30 records pursuant to chapter 22. The state board and local
1 31 boards, with respect to hearings involving specific children
1 32 receiving foster care and the child's family, are not subject
1 33 to chapter 21.

1 34 3. Members of the state board and local boards, court
1 35 appointed special advocates, and the employees of the
2 1 department and the department of inspections and appeals are
2 2 subject to standards of confidentiality pursuant to sections
2 3 217.30, 228.6, subsection 1, sections 235A.15, 600.16, and
2 4 600.16A. Members of the state and local boards, court
2 5 appointed special advocates, and employees of the department
2 6 and the department of inspections and appeals who disclose
2 7 information or records of the board or department, other than
2 8 as provided in subsection 2, are guilty of a simple
2 9 misdemeanor.
