               Such The examination and copying of public records
    13 shall be done under the supervision of the lawful custodian of
    14 the records or the custodian's authorized designee. The
    15 lawful custodian shall not require the physical presence of
  1 16 person requesting or receiving a copy of a public record and
    17 shall fulfill requests for a copy of a public record received 18 in writing, by telephone, or by electronic means. Fulfillment
    19 of a request for a copy of a public record may be contingent
    20 upon receipt of payment of expenses to be incurred in
    21 fulfilling the request and such estimated expenses shall be
    22 communicated to the requester upon receipt of the request.
  1 23 The lawful custodian may adopt and enforce reasonable rules
    24 regarding the work examination and copying of the records and
  1 25 the protection of the records against damage or 1 26 disorganization. The lawful custodian shall provide a

     9 directly attributable to supervising the examination of and
    10 making and providing copies of public records. Actual costs
    11 shall not include charges for ordinary expenses or costs such
    12 as employment benefits, depreciation, maintenance,
    13 electricity, or insurance associated with the administration 14 of the office of the lawful custodian.
