           SEC. 21. MILITARY PAY DIFFERENTIAL.
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  1 14 <u>1. There Notwithstanding section 8.56, subsection 4, there</u> 1 15 is appropriated from the cash reserve fund to the department
  1 16 of revenue and finance or its successor agency for the period
  1 17 beginning March 19, 2003, and ending June 30, 2003, the 1 18 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the
  1 19 purposes designated:
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           For a military pay differential program and health
    21 insurance retention program for individuals activated for the
  1 22 armed services of the United States, for employees on the
  1 23 central payroll system and for the other military service=
       related purposes designated in this section:
  1 27 $10,000 is transferred to the Iowa department of public health 1 28 for allocation to community mental health centers to provide
  1 29 counseling services to persons, whether or not employed by the
    <u>30 state</u>, who are members of the national guard and or reservists
    31 activated but as yet not sent to combat zones and who are
        assigned to active duty service in the armed forces of the
    33 United States and to the persons' family members. The
    34 sessions shall be provided on a first come, first served basis
  1 35 and shall be limited to three visits per family.
           3. Of the funds appropriated in this section, $100,000
       shall be retained by the department of administrative services

    15 event an eligible member is deceased, the surviving spouse of 16 the eligible member shall be eligible for a loan under the 17 program, subject to the surviving spouse meeting the program's
    18 eligibility requirements other than the military service
    19 requirement. For the purposes of this subsection,

    21 resident of this state who is a member of the national guard,

    4 national guard and reserves of the armed forces of the United
    5 States and the members' immediate families until expended.
