1 1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 2001 2 1 1 ٦ A JOINT RESOLUTION 1 4 1 5 AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WINE IN THE STATE CAPITOL IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE AWARDS CEREMONY OF 1 6 1 7 THE WORLD FOOD PRIZE FOUNDATION. 1 8 the State of Iowa has the honor of being the home 1 9 WHEREAS, 1 10 of the World Food Prize Foundation which annually presents an 1 11 international award recognizing outstanding individual 1 12 achievement in improving the quality, quantity, or 1 13 availability of food in the world; and 1 14 WHEREAS, Iowa's unique State Capitol is an optimal location 1 15 for this awards ceremony of the World Food Prize Foundation 1 16 and previously served as the ceremony location; and 1 17 WHEREAS, wine is customarily served as an accompaniment to 1 18 the food and entertainment provided at this type of awards 1 19 ceremony and wine was served when the ceremony was previously 1 20 held at the State Capitol; and 1 21 WHEREAS, under 11 IAC 100.4(8), which prohibits the 1 22 consumption of alcoholic beverages on the capitol complex, it 23 is not possible to serve wine at this type of awards ceremony 1 1 24 in the State Capitol; NOW THEREFORE, 1 25 26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 1 1 27 1 27 1 28 Section 1. Notwithstanding 11 IAC 100.4(8) and any 1 29 contrary provisions of chapter 123, prohibiting the use and 1 30 consumption of alcoholic beverages in public places, wine may 1 31 be used and consumed within the state capitol at an awards 1 32 ceremony, to be held on or around October 19, 2006, hosted and 1 33 organized in whole or in part by the world food prize 1 34 foundation if the person providing the food and wine at the 35 awards ceremony possesses an appropriate valid liquor control 1 license.
