PAG LIN SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 7 1 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION 4 AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WINE AND BEER IN THE STATE CAPITOL IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 2005 NATIONAL 1 GOVERNORS ASSOCIATION ANNUAL MEETING. 1 6 1 WHEREAS, the National Governors Association is a 1 Я 9 prestigious group representing every state in the United 1 10 States; and WHEREAS, the annual meeting of the National Governors 1 11 1 12 Association brings together a bipartisan group of leaders to 1 13 discuss and find solutions to problems faced by the states; 14 and 1 1 15 WHEREAS, wine and beer are customarily served as an 1 16 accompaniment to food and entertainment at social events for 1 17 participants attending the annual meeting; and WHEREAS, under 11 IAC 100.4(8), which prohibits the 1 18 1 19 consumption of alcoholic beverages on the capitol complex, it 20 is not possible to serve wine and beer at social events in the 21 State Capitol; NOW THEREFORE, 1 1 1 22 1 23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 1 24 Section 1. Notwithstanding 11 IAC 100.4(8) and any 1 2.5 1 26 contrary provisions of chapter 123, prohibiting the use and 1 27 consumption of alcoholic beverages in public places, wine and 1 28 beer may be used and consumed within the state capitol at a 1 29 social event, to be held on or around July 15, 2005, hosted by 30 Governor Vilsack in conjunction with the 2005 annual meeting 31 of the National Governors Association, if the person providing 32 the food and wine and beer at the social event possesses an 33 appropriate valid liquor control license.
