AN ACT

RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE ELECTORS' SIGNATURES  
NECESSARY IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROPOSE AT A REGULAR  
ELECTION THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING FREE TEXTBOOKS FOR  
THE USE OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S PUPILS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 301.24, Code 2005, is amended to read  
as follows:

301.24 PETITION -- ELECTION.


Whenever a petition signed by one hundred eligible electors  
residing in the school district or a number of eligible  
electors residing in the school district equal in-number to at  
least ten percent of the registered number of voters in the  
last preceding regular school district, to be determined by  
the school board of any school district, shall be election,  
whichever is greater, is filed with the secretary thirty days  
or more before the regular election, asking that the question  
of providing free textbooks for the use of pupils in the  
public schools thereof school district's attendance centers be  
submitted to the voters at the next regular election, the

secretary shall cause notice of such proposition to be given in the notice of such election.
