The above House Files are hereby approved this date.



HOUSE FILE 2564

AN ACT

RELATING TO NOTIFICATION OF PARENTS, GUARDIANS, OR CUSTODIANS OF CHILDREN RECEIVING CHILD CARE FROM AN UNREGISTERED CHILD CARE HOME WHEN IT IS DETERMINED THAT CHILD ABUSE INVOLVING THE HOME HAS OCCURRED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 237A.5, subsection 2, paragraph f, Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:

f. If it has been determined that a child receiving child care from a child care facility or a child care home which receives-public-funding-for-providing-child-care is the victim of founded child abuse committed by an employee, license or registration holder, child care home provider, or resident of the child care facility or child care home for which a report is placed in the central registry pursuant to section 232.71D, the administrator shall provide notification at the time of the determination to the parents, guardians, and custodians of children receiving care from the <u>child care</u> facility or child care home. A notification made under this paragraph shall

identify the type of abuse but shall not identify the victim or perpetrator or circumstances of the founded abuse.
