AN ARREST WARRANT.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 804.29, Code 2005, is amended to read
as follows:

804.29 CONFIDENTIALITY.


All information filed with the court for the purpose of
securing a warrant for an arrest, including but not limited to
a citation and affidavits, shall be a confidential record
until such time as a peace officer has made the arrest and has
made the officer's return on the warrant. During the period
of time that information is confidential, it shall be sealed
by the court and the information contained therein shall not
be disseminated to any person other than a peace officer,

employee of a county attorney's office, magistrate, or another court employee, in the course of official duties.
