

SENATE FILE 365

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR CERTIFICATION OF ENTERPRISE ZONES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 15E.192, subsection 3, paragraph b, Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:

b. A county or city may apply to the department for an area to be certified as an enterprise zone at any time prior to July-1,-2005 March 1, 2006. However, the total amount of land designated as enterprise zones under subsections 1 and 2, and any other enterprise zones certified by the department, excluding those approved pursuant to section 15E.194,

subsection 4, shall not exceed in the aggregate one percent of the total county area.
