I hereby transmit:

Senate File 78, an Act relating to the exemption from city taxes of land included in an application for voluntary annexation or in a city's involuntary annexation petition and including effective and applicability date provisions.

Senate File 350, an Act relating to child support recovery including access to information for the purposes of recovery, provisions relating to failure to withhold income or to pay the amounts withheld, and to the suspension of a child support obligation, the satisfaction of support payments, nullifying related administrative rules and providing penalties.

Senate File 404, an Act providing for county eligibility for state payment of property tax relief moneys and allowed growth funding for mental health, mental retardation, and developmental disabilities services and providing effective and retroactive applicability dates.



SENATE FILE 404

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR COUNTY ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE PAYMENT OF PROPERTY
TAX RELIEF MONEYS AND ALLOWED GROWTH FUNDING FOR MENTAL
HEALTH, MENTAL RETARDATION, AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
SERVICES AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE AND RETROACTIVE
APPLICABILITY DATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
Section 1. STATE PAYMENT TO ELIGIBLE COUNTIES.

Notwithstanding section 331.439, subsection 1, paragraph "a",
a county that accurately reported the county's expenditures
for mental health, mental retardation, and developmental
disabilities services for the previous fiscal year on the
forms prescribed by the department of human services, and the
report was received after December 1, 2004, and on or before
March 15, 2005, shall be eligible for state payment, as
defined in section 331.438, in accordance with section 331.439
and other law providing for the state payment in the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 2004.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment and applies retroactively to December 2, 2004.
