Section 261.1, subsections 3 and 4, Code 2007, 1 9 1 10 are amended to read as follows: 11 3. <u>a.</u> A member <u>Two members</u> of the senate, <u>one</u> to be 12 appointed by the president of the senate, <u>after consultation</u> A member <u>Two members</u> of the senate, one to be 1 11 1 13 with the majority leader and one to be appointed by the 1 1 14 minority leader of the senate, to serve as an ex officio_ 1 15 nonvoting member for a term of four years beginning on July 1 1 16 of the year of appointment members. 1 17 <u>b.</u> A member <u>Two members</u> of the house of representatives, 18 one to be appointed by the speaker of the house of 19 representatives and one to be appointed by the minority leader 20 of the house of representatives, to serve as an ex officio, 1 21 nonvoting member for a term of four years beginning on July 1 1 22 of the year of appointment members. The members of the senate and house of representatives 1 23 24 shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing legislator for a 25 term beginning upon the convening of the general assembly and 26 expiring upon the convening of the following general assembly. 27 or when the appointee's successor is appointed, whichever 28 occurs later. 1 29 Sec. 2. Section 261.1, subsection 5, unnumbered paragraph 1 30 1, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows: 1 31 Eight additional members to be appointed by the governor. 32 One of the members shall be selected to represent private 1 33 colleges, private and universities and private junior colleges 1 1 34 located in the state of Iowa. When appointing this member, 35 the governor shall give careful consideration to any person or 1 2 1 persons nominated or recommended by any organization or 2 association of some or all private colleges, private and 2 3 universities and private junior colleges located in the state 4 of Iowa. One of the members shall be selected to represent 5 community colleges located in the state of Iowa. When 2 2 2 2 6 appointing this member, the governor shall give careful 2 7 consideration to any person or persons nominated or 2 8 recommended by any organization or association of Iowa 2 9 community colleges. One member shall be enrolled as a student 2 10 at a board of regents institution, community college, or 2 11 accredited private institution. One member shall be a 2 12 representative of a lending institution located in this state. 2 13 One member shall be a representative of the Iowa student loan 14 liquidity corporation an individual who is repaying or has 15 repaid a student loan guaranteed by the commission. The other 2 2 16 three members, none of whom shall be official board members or 2 17 trustees of an institution of higher learning or of an 2 18 association of institutions of higher learning, shall be 2 19 selected to represent the general public. 2 20 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE AND APPLICABILITY DATE. 2 21 1. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes 2 22 effect upon enactment. 2 23 2. The Act applies to members of the general assembly 2 24 appointed to the college student aid commission before, on, or 2 25 after the effective date of this Act. 3. The membership of the person who is the Iowa student 2 26 2 27 loan liquidity corporation representative on the college 2 28 student aid commission is terminated on the effective date of 29 this Act. The term of the initial appointment of the 2 2 30 individual who is repaying or repaid a student loan guaranteed 2 2 2 31 by the commission shall expire on the date the term of the 32 Iowa student loan liquidity corporation representative would 33 have ended but for enactment of this Act. 2 34 2 35 3 1 2 3 PATRICK J.
