Section 726.23, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code 1 9 1 10 2007, is amended to read as follows: a. A parent or guardian has given written authorization 1 11 1 12 for the taking of the fingerprints for use in the future in 1 13 case the child becomes a runaway or a missing child. Only one 1 14 set of prints shall be taken and the <u>completed</u> fingerprint 1 15 cards <u>and written authorizations</u> shall be given to the parent 1 16 or guardian. The fingerprints, written authorizations for 1 17 fingerprinting, or notice of the fingerprints' existence shall 18 not be recorded, stored, or kept in any manner by a law 19 enforcement agency, except as provided in this subchapter or 1 1 1 20 except at the request of the parent or quardian if the child 1 21 becomes a runaway or a missing child. When the child is 1 22 located or the case is otherwise disposed of, the fingerprint 1 23 cards shall be returned to the parents or guardian. Nothing in this paragraph "a" shall be construed to 25 prohibit a governmental unit from taking the fingerprints of a 26 child at the Iowa state fair or a county or district fair as 27 defined in section 174.1 as long as the governmental unit 1 24 1 28 complies with the requirements of this paragraph "a". 1 29 1 30 1 31 PATRICK J.
