Licensing 1 21 authority, which includes the authority to establish criteria 1 22 for the licenses; establish issuance and renewal requirements; 1 23 create application and renewal forms; create licenses that 1 24 authorize different instructional functions or specialties; 1 25 develop a code of professional rights and responsibilities, 1 26 practices, and ethics, which shall, among other things, 1 27 address the failure of a practitioner to fulfill contractual 28 obligations under section 279.13; and develop any other 1 1 29 classifications, distinctions, and procedures which may be 1 30 necessary to exercise licensing duties. A majority of the licensed practitioner members shall 2 be nonadministrative practitioners. Four of the members shall 2 3 be administrators. Members shall elect a 6 chairperson of the board. Members, except for the director of 7 the department of education <u>or the director's designee</u>, shall 2 2 2 8 be appointed by the governor subject to confirmation by the 2 9 senate. 2 2 2 Sec. 4. 10 Section 272.4, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 11 1, Code Supplement 2007, is amended to read as follows: 12 Members, except for the director of the department of 2 12 2 13 education or the director's designee, shall be appointed to 2 14 serve staggered terms of four years. A member shall not serve 2 15 more than two consecutive terms, except for the director of 2 16 the department of education or the director's designee, who 2 17 shall serve until the director's term of office expires.
