1 5 OF RESERVE PEACE OFFICERS.

1 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 9 Section 1. Section 80D.1A, Code 2007, is amended to read
1 10 as follows:
1 11 80D.1A DEFINITIONS.
1 12 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
1 13 requires:
1 14 1. "Academy" means the Iowa law enforcement academy.
1 15 2. "Council" means the Iowa law enforcement academy
1 16 council.
1 17 ~~3. "Minimum training course" means a curriculum of one~~
1 18 ~~hundred fifty hours of training and instruction required for~~
1 19 ~~certification as a reserve peace officer, excluding weapons~~
1 20 ~~training basic training requirements developed by the academy~~
1 21 ~~pursuant to the academy's rulemaking authority that a reserve~~
1 22 ~~peace officer must complete within a prescribed time period to~~
1 23 ~~become state certified as a reserve peace officer. The~~
1 24 ~~minimum training course does not include required weapons~~
1 25 ~~training.~~
1 26 ~~4. "Reserve force" means an organization of reserve~~
1 27 ~~peace officers established as provided in this chapter.~~
1 28 ~~5. "Reserve peace officer" means a volunteer,~~
1 29 ~~nonregular, sworn member of a law enforcement agency who~~
1 30 ~~serves with or without compensation, has regular police powers~~
1 31 ~~while functioning as a law enforcement agency's~~
1 32 ~~representative, and participates on a regular basis in the law~~
1 33 ~~enforcement agency's activities including crime prevention and~~
1 34 ~~control, preservation of the peace, and enforcement of law.~~
1 35 Sec. 2. Section 80D.3, Code 2007, is amended to read as
2 1 follows:
2 2 80D.3 TRAINING STANDARDS.
2 3 1. Each person appointed to serve as a reserve peace
2 4 officer shall satisfactorily complete a minimum training
2 5 course as ~~provided in this section established by academy~~
2 6 ~~rules.~~ In addition, if a reserve peace officer is authorized
2 7 to carry weapons, the officer shall satisfactorily complete
2 8 the same training course in the use of weapons as is required
2 9 for basic training of regular peace officers by the ~~Iowa law~~
2 10 ~~enforcement academy.~~ The minimum training course for reserve
2 11 peace officers ~~must shall~~ be satisfactorily completed within
2 12 ~~four years from the date of appointment the time period~~
2 13 ~~prescribed by academy rules. If reserve Academy=approved~~
2 14 ~~reserve peace officer training received before July 1, 1990,~~
2 15 ~~meets the requirements of this section, the training 2007, may~~
2 16 ~~be applied to meet the minimum training course requirements of~~
2 17 ~~this section established by academy rules.~~
2 18 2. A reserve peace officer who does not carry a weapon
2 19 shall not be required to complete a weapons training course,
2 20 but the officer shall comply with all other training
2 21 requirements.
2 22 3. A person appointed to serve as a reserve peace officer,
2 23 who has received basic training as a peace officer and has
2 24 been certified by the ~~Iowa law enforcement~~ academy pursuant to
2 25 chapter 80B and rules adopted pursuant to chapter 80B, may be
2 26 exempted from completing the minimum training course at the
2 27 discretion of the appointing authority, ~~if the officer meets~~
2 28 ~~one of the following qualifications:~~
2 29 a. ~~The appointee is serving as a regular peace officer~~
2 30 ~~with a bona fide law enforcement agency when the application~~
2 31 ~~for a reserve peace officer appointment is made.~~
2 32 b. ~~The appointee has served as a regular peace officer~~
2 33 ~~with a bona fide law enforcement agency within three years of~~
2 34 ~~the date of application for appointment as a reserve peace~~
2 35 ~~officer. However, such a person appointed to serve as a~~
3 1 reserve peace officer shall meet mandatory in-service training
3 2 requirements established by academy rules if the person has
3 3 not served as an active peace officer within one hundred

3 4 ~~eighty days of appointment as a reserve peace officer.~~

3 5 4. The minimum training course required for a reserve
3 6 peace officer shall be conducted pursuant to sections 80D.4
3 7 and 80D.7, ~~and the following training schedule:~~

3 8 a. ~~During the first year, thirty hours of general law
3 9 enforcement training is required as provided in section 80D.4
3 10 and as prescribed by the Iowa law enforcement academy council.~~

3 11 If weapons are to be carried, a reserve peace officer shall
3 12 complete a weapons training course having the same number of
3 13 hours of training as is required of regular peace officers in
3 14 basic training pursuant to section 80D.7.

3 15 b. ~~During the second through the fourth year, forty hours
3 16 of training shall be provided each year. Ten hours annually
3 17 shall be obtained by each reserve peace officer working with a
3 18 regular peace officer. The remaining thirty hours annually
3 19 shall be selected by the appointing authority from the
3 20 approved basic training curriculum established by the Iowa law
3 21 enforcement academy for use in training regular peace
3 22 officers.~~

3 23 c. ~~Notwithstanding the time schedule provided in this
3 24 subsection, a~~ A person is eligible for state certification as
3 25 a reserve peace officer upon satisfactory completion of the
3 26 ~~one hundred fifty hours of training required for certification
3 27 and testing requirements specified by academy rules. A
3 28 reserve peace officer enrolled in an academy=approved minimum
3 29 course of training prior to July 1, 2007, shall obtain state
3 30 certification by July 1, 2012.~~

3 31 Sec. 3. Section 80D.4, Code 2007, is amended to read as
3 32 follows:

3 33 80D.4 TRAINING.

3 34 Training for individuals appointed as reserve peace
3 35 officers shall be provided by ~~that law enforcement agency, but
4 1 may be obtained instructors~~ in a community college or other
4 2 facility, ~~including a law enforcement agency,~~ selected by the
4 3 individual and approved by the law enforcement agency ~~and the
4 4 academy.~~ Upon satisfactory completion of training required by
4 5 the ~~Iowa law enforcement academy, the chief of police,
4 6 sheriff, commissioner of public safety, or director of the
4 7 judicial district department of correctional services academy~~
4 8 shall certify the individual as a reserve peace officer.

4 9 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 80D.4A TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION
4 10 REQUIREMENTS.

4 11 The director of the academy, subject to the approval of the
4 12 council, shall promulgate rules in accordance with the
4 13 provisions of this chapter and chapter 17A, giving due
4 14 consideration to varying factors and special requirements of
4 15 law enforcement agencies relative to the standardized training
4 16 and state certification of reserve peace officers.
