

## AN ACT

REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO STUDY THE ACCEPTANCE OF ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS AT ITS CUSTOMER SERVICE SITES AND SITES OPERATED BY COUNTY TREASURERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS TO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION -- STUDY. The department of transportation
shall review the current methods the department employs for
the collection of fees and other revenues at sites operated by
county treasurers under chapter 321M and at customer service
sites operated by the department. In conducting its review,
the department, in cooperation with the treasurer of state,
shall consider providing an electronic payment option for all
of its customers. The department shall report its findings
and recommendations by December 31, 2008, to the senate and
house standing committees on transportation regarding the
