

HOUSE FILE 2268

AN ACT

MAKING SPECIFIED REVISIONS TO THE CONSUMER CREDIT CODE TO CONFORM TO FEDERAL STATUTORY UPDATES AND PROHIBIT THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF A MOTOR VEHICLE PURSUANT TO A CONSUMER RENTAL PURCHASE AGREEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 537.1302, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows:

537.1302 DEFINITION -- TRUTH IN LENDING ACT.

As used in this chapter, "Truth in Lending Act" means Title 1 of the Consumer Credit Protection Act, in subchapter 1 of 15 U.S.C. ch. 41, as amended to and including January 1, ±998 2008, and includes regulations issued pursuant to that Act prior to January 1, ±998 2008.

- Sec. 2. Section 537.3604, subsection 7, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 7. "Personal property" means any property that is not real property under the laws of this state when it is made available for a consumer rental purchase agreement. For the purposes of this part, "personal property" does not include a

motor vehicle, a manufactured home, or a manufactured or mobile home as defined in section 321.1.
