AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF SECURITY PROCEDURES OR  
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS INFORMATION DISCUSSED AT A MEETING  
OF A GOVERNMENTAL BODY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 21.5, subsection 1, paragraph k, Code  
2007, is amended to read as follows:

k. To discuss information contained in records in the  
custody of a ~~public-airport, municipal-corporation, municipal  
utility, jointly-owned-municipal-utility, or-rural-water~~  
district-organized-under-chapter-357A, governmental body that  
are confidential records pursuant to section 22.7, subsection  
46 50. ~~This-paragraph-is-repealed-effective-June-30,--2007.~~

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
