SENATE FILE 406

AN ACT

RELATING TO DOGS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO KILL A TAGGED DOG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 351.27, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows:

351.27 RIGHT TO KILL TAGGED DOG.

It shall be lawful for any person to kill a dog, wearing a collar with a rabies vaccination tag attached, when the dog is caught in the act of worrying, chasing, maiming, or killing
