House File 2384, an Act requiring the lowa department of veterans affairs to advise deploying service members regarding certain issues related to taxation.



AN ACT

REQUIRING THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TO ADVISE DEPLOYING SERVICE MEMBERS REGARDING CERTAIN ISSUES RELATED TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 35A.5, Code Supplement 2009, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 15A. In coordination with the military division of the department of public defense, advise service members prior to, and after returning from, deployment on active duty service outside the United States of issues related to the filing of tax returns and the payment of taxes due and encourage
