AN ACT

MAKING CHANGES TO THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 124.206, subsection 3, Code 2009, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. *ab.* Tapentadol.

Sec. 2. Section 124.210, subsection 3, Code 2009, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. *az.* Fospropofol.


Sec. 3. Section 124.212, subsection 5, Code Supplement 2009, is amended to read as follows:


5. *Depressants.* Unless specifically exempted or excluded or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation that contains any quantity of any of the following ~~substane~~ substances having a depressant effect

on the central nervous system, including ~~its~~ salts of such substances: pregabalin


a. Lacosamide [(R)-2-acetoamido-N-benzyl-3-methoxy-propionamide].

b. Pregabalin [(S)-3-(aminomethyl)-5-methylhexanoic acid].


