

HOUSE FILE 321

AN ACT

EXEMPTING CERTAIN PERSONS WHO TRANSPORT MEMBERS OF THE IOWA VETERANS HOME FROM THE REQUIREMENT TO BE LICENSED AS A CHAUFFEUR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.1, subsection 8, Code 2009, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. If authorized to transport patients or residents of the Iowa veterans home by the commandant or the commandant's designee, an employee of or volunteer at the Iowa veterans home is not a chauffeur when

transporting the patients or residents in an automobile in the course of the employee's or volunteer's normal duties.
