AN ACT
RELATING TO REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS
INVOLVING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY RESERVE PEACE
OFFICERS.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.267A, subsection 4, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:


4. For the purposes of this section, "*certified law enforcement officer*" ~~means~~ includes a law enforcement officer who is certified through the Iowa law enforcement academy as provided in section 80B.13, subsection 3, or ~~section 80B.17~~


a reserve peace officer certified through the Iowa law enforcement academy as provided in section 80D.4A.
