

House File 426

AN ACT

RELATING TO REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS INVOLVING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY RESERVE PEACE OFFICERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.267A, subsection 4, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

4. For the purposes of this section, "certified law enforcement officer" means includes a law enforcement officer who is certified through the Iowa law enforcement academy as provided in section 80B.13, subsection 3, or section 80B.17

a reserve peace officer certified through the Iowa law enforcement academy as provided in section 80D.4A.
