SENATE FILE 176

AN ACT

ALLOWING THE WAIVER OF CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES FOR LATE ANNUAL REPORTS CONCERNING CEMETERY AND FUNERAL MERCHANDISE, AND FUNERAL SERVICES, UPON A SHOWING OF GOOD CAUSE OR FINANCIAL HARDSHIP AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 523A.204, subsection 4, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

4. The commissioner shall levy an administrative penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars against a preneed seller that fails to file the annual report when due, payable to the state for deposit in the general fund of the state. <u>However,</u> <u>the commissioner may waive the administrative penalty upon a</u> <u>showing of good cause or financial hardship.</u>

Sec. 2. Section 523A.502A, subsection 3, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

3. The commissioner shall levy an administrative penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars against a sales agent who fails to file an annual report when due, payable to the state for deposit in the general fund. <u>However, the</u> <u>commissioner may waive the administrative penalty upon a</u> <u>showing of good cause or financial hardship.</u>
