AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOME MODIFICATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE MEDICAID HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES WAIVER FOR THE ELDERLY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. HOME MODIFICATION — REVIEW OF REQUIREMENTS. The department of human services, in consultation with the department on aging, area agencies on aging, and other organizations representing the interests of older Iowans, shall review the requirements for home modification under the medical assistance home and community-based services waiver for the elderly, including the lifetime cap, and shall present a plan to
