

SENATE FILE 334

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES CHARGED WITH PROVIDING GOVERNMENT OVERSIGHT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 2.45, subsection 5, Code 2009, is amended by striking the subsection.

Sec. 2. Section 7C.12, subsection 2, paragraph c, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

c. Shall report quarterly any reallocation of the amount of the state ceiling by the governor's designee in accordance with this chapter to the *legislative* general assembly's <u>standing committees on</u> government oversight committee and the auditor of state. The report shall contain, at a minimum, the amount of each reallocation, the date of each reallocation, the name of the political subdivision and a description of all bonds issued pursuant to a reallocation, a brief explanation of the reason for the reallocation, and such other information as may be required by the-committee a standing committee on government oversight.

Sec. 3. Section 29C.20A, subsection 4, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

4. The homeland security and emergency management division shall submit an annual report, by January 1 of each year, to the legislative fiscal committee and the legislative general
assembly's standing committees on government oversight

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committee concerning the activities of the grant program in the previous fiscal year.

Sec. 4. Section 34A.7A, subsection 3, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

3. a. The program manager shall submit an annual report by January 15 of each year to the <u>legislative general</u> <u>assembly's standing committees on</u> government oversight committee advising the general assembly of the status of E911 implementation and operations, including both wire-line and wireless services, the distribution of surcharge receipts, and an accounting of the revenues and expenses of the E911 program.

b. The program manager shall submit a calendar quarter report of the revenues and expenses of the E911 program to the fiscal services division of the legislative services agency.

c. The legislative general assembly's standing committees on government oversight committee shall review the priorities of distribution of funds under this chapter at least every two years.

Sec. 5. Section 523A.801, subsection 3, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

3. The commissioner shall submit an annual report to the legislative general assembly's standing committees on government oversight committee by October 1 of each year reporting on the administration of this chapter. The report shall set forth any recommendations for changes in the law that the commissioner deems necessary or desirable to prevent abuses or evasions of this chapter or rules implementing this chapter or to rectify undesirable conditions in connection with the administration of this chapter or rules implementing this chapter.

Sec. 6. Section 523I.201, subsection 3, Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

3. The commissioner shall submit an annual report to the legislative general assembly's standing committees on
government
oversight committee by October 1 of each year
reporting on the administration of this chapter. The report
shall set forth any recommendations for changes in the law
that the commissioner deems necessary or desirable to prevent
abuses or evasions of this chapter or rules implementing this

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chapter or to rectify undesirable conditions in connection with the administration of this chapter or rules implementing this chapter.
