SENATE FILE 336

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR WAIVERS OF CERTAIN COMMUNITY ATTRACTION AND TOURISM PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. COMMUNITY ATTRACTION AND TOURISM WAIVERS.

1. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010, an applicant for financial assistance under the community attraction and tourism program or the river enhancement community attraction and tourism program created in chapter 15F may apply to the vision Iowa board for a waiver of any local or private matching moneys required of the applicant by the board pursuant to section 15F.202 if the applicant is located in an area declared a disaster area by the governor or by a federal official. The board may grant all or a portion of the applicant's waiver request.

If the board receives repayments of or recaptures financial assistance awarded in a fiscal year prior to the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010, the board may grant all or a portion of an applicant's waiver request pursuant to this subsection 1 and use the repayments or recaptured financial assistance to provide financial assistance under this subsection to an applicant during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010.

2. The board shall provide a report to the general assembly, the governor, and the legislative services agency describing any waivers granted pursuant to this Act.
