House File 290

AN ACT

TO ALLOW THE USE OF MOTORCYCLES EQUIPPED WITH DETACHABLE STABILIZING REAR WHEELS ON IOWA ROADS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 321.435 Motorcycles equipped with detachable stabilizing wheels.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a motor vehicle that is originally designed as a two-wheeled motorcycle and is modified using conversion hardware which allows for the attachment and detachment of two stabilizing rear wheels may be operated on a highway with the stabilizing wheels attached in accordance with the provisions of this chapter applicable to motorcycles. A motorcycle shall not be determined to be

reconstructed based on the sole fact that two stabilizing wheels have been added as described in this section.
