AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION THE BOARD OF EDUCATIONAL EXAMINERS IS REQUIRED TO REVIEW REGARDING APPLICANTS FOR LICENSE RENEWAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 272.2, subsection 17, Code 2015, is amended to read as follows:

17. Adopt rules to require that a background investigation be conducted by the division of criminal investigation of the department of public safety on all initial applicants for licensure. The board shall also require all initial applicants to submit a completed fingerprint packet and shall use the packet to facilitate a national criminal history background check. The board shall have access to, and shall review the sex offender registry information under section 692A.121 available to the general public, information in the Iowa court information system available to the general public, the central registry for child abuse information established under chapter 235A, and the dependent adult abuse records maintained under

chapter 235B for information regarding applicants for license renewal.
