

## AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF COUNTY FUNDS BY ECCLESIASTICAL AND SECTARIAN INSTITUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 331.901, subsection 5, Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:

5. A county or township officer or employee shall not appropriate, give, or loan public funds to or in favor of an institution, school, association, or object which that is under ecclesiastical or sectarian management or control unless the public funds are to be utilized for a project or program

that benefits the public and does not require any religious or sectarian services, educational programs, or participation requirements.
