AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF ACCESSIBLE PRESCRIPTION-RELATED MEASURES FOR PERSONS WHO ARE BLIND, HAVE A VISUAL IMPAIRMENT, OR OTHER PRINT DISABILITY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:


Section 1. NEW SECTION. 155A.49 Accessible prescription-related measures — persons who are blind, visually impaired, or have other print disabilities.

1. The board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to ensure that on or before January 1, 2027, if a person who is blind, has a visual impairment, or other print disability requests access to prescription drug labels, bag tags, and medical guides, a pharmacy provides access to prescription drug labels, bag tags, and medical guides, or refers the person to a pharmacy that provides access to prescription drug labels, bag tags, and medical guides. The accessibility measures shall




Sec. 2. ACCESSIBLE PRESCRIPTION-RELATED MEASURES —  
REPORT. The board of pharmacy shall submit a report to the  
governor and the general assembly on or before January 1,  
2028, that provides a summary of the progress on implementing  
rules, and recommendations for additional measures to improve
